


Terms and Conditions:

Canoeing can take place between <u>18th</u> October and <u>15th</u> March inclusive.

In the event of high water outside this period, additional access is granted when the water height on the gauge at Llanstephan is above the red marker.

The general terms and conditions described earlier always apply.





Newbridge Access/Exit

Directions:


From Builth Wells take the A470 north towards Rhayader. On the other side of Newbridge on Wye, take the left turn onto the B4358 to Beulah. Access to the river is from the right bank on the <u>upstream side</u> of the bridge only.

Unloading and Parking:

Unloading and parking is possible in the lay-by on your left immediately after crossing the bridge. Parking is also possible on the hard-standing directly opposite this lay-by.

Accessing the water: WARNING!!!!

Use the path leading from the stile down to the river from the end small car park on the upstream side of the bridge. This is an important fish spawning area, especially for salmon in the winter and for grayling in April. <u>YOU</u> MUST ENSURE THAT YOU DO NOT DISTURB THE GRAVELS WITH PADDLES OR BY TREADING ON THE RIVERBED.



Builth Wells Access/Exit

Directions:

Follow the Builth one-way system through the high street and round until you come to the Groe public car park on your left (entrance next to the Tourist Information Centre).

Loading:

The car park is a short distance to the exit point on the right bank above the bridge.
